



NOTICE TO ALL CONCERNED

**SUBJECT: CASE NO. 09-ANM-10NR
PROPOSED DECOMMISSIONING
NON-DIRECTIONAL BEACON (NDB)
EUGENE, OR**

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has conducted an aeronautical study of a proposal to decommission the Eugene, OR (EUG) NDB. The physical condition of the shelter housing the NDB has deteriorated and it is scheduled for replacement and upgrade. The FAA proposes to decommission and remove the antenna, NDB and associated hardware infrastructure in order to permanently defray the cost of shelter replacement and routine maintenance. Ancillary to decommissioning and removal of the NDB, an amendment of the ILS or LOC Y RWY 16R is required as the procedure would become DME REQUIRED; however this procedure would become unnecessary and could be cancelled, as the existing ILS or LOC/DME Z RWY 16R has identical minimums. The CAT II and CAT III ILS RWY 16R procedure would also be amended to reflect DME REQUIRED. There will be no reclassification of existing airspace and the current Federal Airways will not be affected. The intent of this notice is to inform the flying public of the proposal to decommission and remove the EUG NDB and provide an opportunity to comment.

DATES: Comments must be received on or before November 30, 2009.

OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT: Interested parties are invited to participate in this proposal by submitting such written data, views, or arguments as they may desire. Comments that provide the factual basis supporting the views and suggestions presented

are particularly helpful in developing reasoned decisions on the proposal. Comments are specifically invited on the overall aeronautical, economic, environmental, and energy-related aspects of the proposal. Communications should identify the airspace docket and be submitted to the address listed below. Commenters wishing the FAA to acknowledge receipt of their comments on this notice must submit with the comments a self-addressed, stamped postcard on which the following statement is made: "Comments to Airspace Docket No. 09-ANM-10NR." The postcard will be date/time stamped and returned to the commenter. All communications received on or before the specified closing date for comments will be considered before taking action on the proposal. The proposal contained in this notice may be changed in the light of comments received.
